Fayette County Sheriff's investigators made an arrest on April 21 in connection with an Identity Fraud which occurred on March 31, 2011. Investigators have obtained criminal arrest warrants on Alann'a Richardson, 21, of College Park charging her with Identity Fraud.

This case involved Richardson fraudulently using a Fayette County citizen's bank account information on a forged check and cashing it in the amount of \$550.00. Richardson is currently in the Dekalb County Jail on unrelated charges.

Fayette County Sheriff's investigators made an arrest on April 27 in connection with a cruelty to children case which was reported on April 22, 2011. Investigators have arrested Richard Chris Munoz, 43, of Peachtree City and charged him with Cruelty to Children in the First Degree, Cruelty to Children in the Third Degree, and Battery (Family Violence).

This case involved Munoz physically assaulting his wife and juvenile daughter. The juvenile daughter was taken to Piedmont Fayette Hospital from the minor injuries she received during this altercation and was later released to her mother. Munoz is currently being held on these charges in the Fayette County Jail without bond.

Fayette County Sheriff's investigators made an arrest on May 3, 2011 in connection with a burglary which occurred between September 17, 2010 and February 23, 2011. Investigators have arrested Donald James Anderson, 32, of Griffin and charged him with Burglary.

This case involved Anderson entering into a residence on Pine Knott Road without authority and stealing several items from inside the home. Investigators in this case were able to recover some of the property and restore it to the victim.

Fayette County Sheriff's investigators made an arrest on April 19, 2011 in reference to an inmate at the Fayette County Jail attempting to influence a witness earlier that day. Investigators obtained a criminal arrest warrant for Jason Harold Strickland, 34 of Fayetteville and charged him with Influencing Witnesses.

This case involved Strickland who is an inmate at the Fayette County Jail, attempting to convince a witness to provide corrupt testimony in his favor on a Felony Theft by Taking case. Strickland is currently in the Fayette County Jail awaiting trial on the Felony Theft by Taking case. Investigators have served Strickland with the additional charge.
