Press Information

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Fayette County Sheriff's Investigators with the assistance of the United States Marshal's Service Metro Fugitive Task Force made an arrest on August 3, 2011 in connection with an armed robbery case which occurred earlier that day. Investigators have arrested Arnold A. Floyd Jr., 20, of Union City and charged him with two (2) counts of Armed Robbery, Burglary, two (2) counts of Cruelty to Children in the 1st Degree, two (2) counts of Aggravated Assault and two (2) counts of Kidnapping.

This case involved Floyd and a second suspect entering into a residence on Revina Trail in north Fayette County where they held a 16 and 12 year old at gun point and proceeded to steal approximately \$4,000.00 worth of items from inside the home. The two victims were not injured during the assault.

The victims in this case helped Fayette Investigators positively identify the two suspects which led to the arrest of Floyd at his Union City home. Investigators have obtained numerous felony warrants for the second suspect in this case but are not yet releasing his identity.

Fayette County Sheriff's Investigators made an arrest on July 11, 2011 involving an Identity Fraud which occurred on August 30, 2010 and September 9, 2010. Investigators have arrested Barron Thomas 28, of Jonesboro and charged him with two (2) counts of Identity Fraud.

The case involved Thomas depositing stolen checks taken from two (2) Fayette County victims into his personal bank account. Both checks were altered and deposited into his account in which Mr. Thomas then withdrew the money for his personal use.

Fayette County Sheriff's Investigators made an arrest on July 29, involving an Identity Fraud in which occurred between February and April 2011. Investigators have arrested Desmond Antwone Johnson 34, of Snellville and charged with seven (7) counts of Identity Fraud.

The case involved Johnson stealing seven (7) Georgia Department of Revenue checks belonging to Fayette County victims and fraudulently depositing them into his JP Morgan Chase account.
