Fatal Traffic Crash Information

The Fayette County Sheriff's Office, Traffic Enforcement Section, is investigating a single vehicle traffic crash which resulted in the death of one person. The crash occurred at approximately 3:04 a.m. on Saturday, March 19, 2011 on Inman Road near its intersection with South Jeff Davis Drive, Fayetteville, Georgia.

Mr. Michael S. Summers, 20 years old, of Fayetteville, was operating a 1997 Chevrolet S-10 Pickup Truck southbound on Inman Road. Mr. Summers was alone in his vehicle.

Mr. Summers was driving his pickup truck southbound on Inman Road and, for reasons not yet known, left the roadway on the southbound (right) side. Mr. Summers attempted to steer his vehicle back on to the roadway but over corrected. The pickup truck skidded across Inman Road before leaving the roadway on the northbound side. After leaving the roadway for the second time, Mr. Summers' vehicle overturned before coming to rest against a tree. Following the collision with the tree Mr. Summers' vehicle caught fire.

Mr. Summers, who was not wearing his seatbelt, was ejected from his vehicle, suffering fatal injuries and died at the scene of the crash. Excessive speed was a significant factor in this crash.

This is the 2nd fatal motor vehicle crash to have occurred in un-incorporated Fayette County in 2011.
