Fayette County Sheriff's Investigators made an arrest on November 20 in connection with an identity fraud which occurred on September 15, 2009. Investigator's arrested Archie Hollis Jr., 41, of Atlanta and charged him with two counts of Identity Fraud.

The case involved Hollis cashing two fraudulent checks that belonged to a Fayette County business.

Fayette County Sheriff's Investigators made and arrest on December 2 in connection with a burglary case which was reported on November 29, 2010. Fayette County Investigator's with the assistance of the Peachtree City Police Department and the Coweta County Sheriff's Office have arrested Joseph Michael Robinson, 24, of Peachtree City and charged him with Burglary.

This case involves Robinson forcing entry into Christ's Church at Whitewater located in south Fayette County and stealing an undisclosed amount of money from the church's office.

During this investigation Fayette County Investigators learned of similar burglaries which occurred on November 23, 2010 at the St. Paul's Lutheran Church and the Peachtree City Christian Church in Peachtree City. Two other similar burglaries were reported between the dates of November 14 and November 29, 2010 at the Community Christian Church and Crossroads Church both in Coweta County.

Robinson is currently being held in the Coweta County Jail where he is facing multiple charges associated with the burglaries that took place in each one of these jurisdictions.
