Fayette County Sheriff's investigator's made an arrest on July 14 in connection with three residential burglaries in south Fayette County which occurred between June 10 and July 14, 2010. Investigators have arrested Aaron Micah Goodine, 23, of Fayetteville and charged him with three counts of Burglary.

This case involved Goodine unlawfully entering into three south Fayette County residential garages and stealing property that belonged to the victims. Goodine cooperated with investigators and helped restore the stolen property to the victims.

Fayette County Sheriff's investigators made an arrest on July 2 involving an Identity Theft case which occurred on June 24 and June 25, 2010. Investigators have obtained warrants for Joshua Waldrep, 20, of Fayetteville and charged him with two counts of Financial Transaction Card Fraud and one count of Financial Transaction Card Theft.

This case involved Waldrep stealing the victim's credit card and fraudulently using it at several locations in Fayetteville, Jonesboro and Fairburn.

Fayette County Sheriff's investigators made two arrests on July 13 involving a damaged property case which occurred June 29, 2010. Investigators have arrested Jonathan Garrett Puckett, 17, and William Bradford Mullins, 17, both of Fayetteville. Puckett was charged with Obstructing a Law Enforcement Officer and Mullins was charged with Criminal Trespass.

This case involved Mullins putting graffiti writing on picnic tables located at a park in the Jeff Davis Plantation subdivision which caused damage less then \$500.00 in value. Puckett misled investigators while being interviewed about the incident and was later taken into custody for hindering the investigation.
