Sheriff's Jail personnel receive awards from Georgia Jail Association.

Fayette County Sheriff's Office Jail employees were awarded top honors at the Georgia Jail Association's awards banquet in Macon last night. Three out of the Association's five awards were presented to Fayette County Sheriff's Office employees.

Major Charles Cowart was awarded the Detention Administrator of the year. This award is presented to an individual administrator for significant acts aimed at promoting the ideas and philosophy of the facility and upgrading standards for a positive change. Major Cowart has been employed with the Sheriff's Office since 1980 and has been the Jail Administrator since January, 2009.

Lieutenant Jeffrey Saatkamp was awarded the Detention Supervisor of the year. This award is presented to that supervisor who exhibits leadership ability and managerial skills in dealing with subordinates, and has contributed significantly toward upgrading overall detention operation.
